
- $\#1: \mathsf{GPH}$ no longer provides TB testing at nursing homes and assisted living facilities

- #3: GPH is prioritizing this program with new nurses.





#4: With the trend of increasing number of adults opting to get their vaccines at pharmacies, GPH is holding walk-in clinics twice per month due to reduced use.








































Number of Idenfied Cases in 2019




#5: There was a statewide outbreak of Hep A in 2019. The number of cases in Geauga County could have increased far more than from two to six cases.







Number of Septic Permits Issued




Number of Lot Evaluation Permits Issued




Number of Plumbing Inspections Conducted






Number of Mobile Food Service Permits Issued (#2)






Number of Food Vending Permits Issued (#5)




Number of Retail Food Establishment Permits Issued (#7)




Number of Pool and Spa Permits Issued




Number of Food Vending Inspections Conducted (#6)






Number of School Environment Inspections Conducted




Number of Nuisance Complaints Received






Number of Animal Bite Investigations Conducted




Number of Inspections in 2019
