I. Call to Order

Mr. Tim Goergen, President Pro-Tempore, called the monthly meeting of the Geauga County Board of Health to order at 7:00 p.m.

Board members present: Mr. Timothy Goergen, Dr. Donald Bowers, Ms. Melanie Eppich, and Mrs. Christina Livers. Mr. J. David Benenati was not present.

Staff members present: Robert Weisdack, Health Commissioner; Daniel Mix, Personal Health Services Director; Dr. Bradley Moritz, Medical Director; and Michael Tusick, R.S.

Others present: There was one other person present.

II. Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Goergen asked everyone to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. Approval of Minutes

Mrs. Livers moved to approve the minutes from the January 19, 2010 regular meeting. Dr. Bowers seconded the motion. Ms. Eppich had a correction to the minutes. For the Humphreys' Administrative Hearing, it is listed as Ms. Eppich voting yes. Ms. Eppich was not present at that meeting. Motion carried with a roll call vote. Mr. Goergen, yes; Dr. Bowers, yes; Ms. Eppich, yes; and Mrs. Livers, yes.

IV. Financial Report / Current Expenses

Mrs. Livers moved to approve the Current Expenses January 13, 2010 to February 10, 2010. Dr. Bowers seconded the motion. Motion carried with a roll call vote. Mr. Goergen, yes; Dr. Bowers, yes; Ms. Eppich, yes; and Mrs. Livers, yes.

V. Environmental Health Program Update

A. Meeting with Dr. Alvin Jackson

Mr. Weisdack reported that the meeting with Dr. Jackson was cancelled due to the weather. The meeting will be scheduled for a future date. At the next meeting, Senator Grendell and Senator Neihaus will also be in attendance. Mr. Weisdack stated that he is sending emails to the other group members to get a date for the meeting confirmed. So far, the proposed dates have conflicted with Mr. Weisdack's schedule. It appears that it will be either March 1 or March 2, but hasn't been confirmed yet.

B. Sewage Update

The sewage rules are to take effect July 1, 2010. Mr. Weisdack stated that he is trying to get the State to understand that the proposed sewage systems would cost \$22,000.00 and more. Geauga and Lake Counties are the only counties that seem to be experiencing these high costs.

Dr. Jackson had indicated that his understanding was that the systems cost approximately \$8,500.00. Mr. Weisdack gave Dr. Jackson data showing the cost data. In addition, Mr. Weisdack provided Dr. Jackson with the data showing that many of these NPDES (units) systems are not meeting standards.

Mr. Weisdack stated that he and Mr. Mix are working on the Geauga County Health District 2009 annual report. Mr. Weisdack stated that he is having the Environmental Health staff do some reports and catch up on some house cleaning items when there is too much snow to do inspections.

VI. Personal Health Services Update

A. Public Health Emergency Preparedness

Mr. Mix reported that the first phase has been completed of reporting to the AOHC and Ohio State University for the H1N1 Evaluation project. It was an extensive report that addressed 8 capabilities composed of approximately 120 questions. We will report at least two more times in the next 4 months, but have been told that there will not be nearly as many items covered in the upcoming questionnaires.

The Board was asked to approve the purchase of generators, E-Z up tents and accessories as well as the MRC and CRI Budget.

B. Nursing

H1N1 vaccinations are still being offered at the Friday morning clinics and children's immunization clinics. Clinics have also been held at nursing homes, Notre Dame Convent, churches and community centers. Two clinics were held at Home Savings Bank branches at their request. We will continue collaborating with employers, retail businesses and pharmacies to assure that the private sector's capacity for vaccinating residents.

All live-attenuated nasal spray vaccine and inactivated pediatric dosage have experienced a shortened shelf life. We have picked up all the vaccine from the providers in Geauga County and sent it back to the manufacturer to comply with the non-safety recall.

C. WIC

The WIC January caseload was 980.

D. Health Education

Mr. Mix, Mr. Weisdack and Mrs. Gerzeny will be working on the annual financial report that must be submitted to the Ohio Department of Health by March 1, 2010.
