Mascot Contest

The Lake County General Health District (LCGHD) and Geauga Public Health (GPH) are looking for a “Happy Camper” mascot design to be used on educational print and video materials. We are looking for an original design depicting a person camping or taking part in camping activities. Be creative!

All K-12 students in Lake and Geauga Counties are encouraged to enter the contest for a chance that their original artwork will be chosen.

Entries will be divided by grade level and evaluated by a panel of judges. One winner will be selected from each of the following groupings:

- K-5th grade
- 6th-8th grade
- 9th-12th grade

Winners will be announced in early May and must agree that their original artwork be displayed on LCGHD and GPH educational materials.

Contest Rules

- 1.) Open to students in grades K-12, who attend any public, private, or home school.
- 2.) All entries must be the student’s original artwork; no trademark, copyright, or electronic art.
- 3.) The student’s name or school grade level should not appear or be used as part of the original design.
- 4.) Artwork designs must be on paper or paper stock that is 8-1/2 inches wide by 11 inches long.
- 5.) Only one entry per student. Entries will not be returned.
- 6.) Fill in the entry form below.
- 7.) Winning artwork will become the property of LCGHD and GPH.
- 8.) Winning entries will be used on future print and video educational messaging.
